AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 2 AGREEMENT, made and entered into among Spokane County, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, having offices for the transaction of business at 1116 West Broadway Avenue, Spokane, Washington, 99260, hereinafter referred to as the "County," the City of Spokane, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington, having offices for the transaction of business at 808 West Spokane Falls Blvd, Spokane, Washington, 99201, hereinafter referred to as the "City", and the Spokane County Emergency Services Communication Board, a board created by Spokane County Code Section 1.08B, having offices for the transaction of business at 1618 N. Rebecca, Spokane, Washington, 99217, hereinafter referred to as "911," jointly referred to as the "Parties."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of RCW 36.32.120(6), Spokane County, through the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, has the care of county property and the management of county funds and business; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of chapter 39.34 RCW, ("Interlocal Cooperation Act"), local governmental units make the most efficient use of their powers cooperating with other public entities to provide services in a manner best serving the needs of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the County, City and 911 Board entered into an agreement entitled "EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" under Spokane County Resolution No. 04-0261 and City of Spokane Document No. OPR 03-609. The Agreement provided that the Parties would hire ADCOMM Engineering Company to provide services for work associated with changing the existing alphanumeric paging system to simulcast operation. The Parties agreed that the total contract price for this task would not exceed \$75,000, 50% of which (\$37,500) to be paid by the Spokane Fire Department, 25% of which (\$18,750) to be paid by the Spokane Police Department and 25% of which (\$18,750) to be paid by the Sheriff's Department. The term of the Agreement was for one (1) year commencing March 30, 2004 and terminating March 19, 2005.



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WHEREAS, the County, City and 911 Board entered into an agreement entitled "AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" under Spokane County Resolution No. 05-0920 and dated December 5, 2005 by the City and January 3, 2006 by the 911 Board, wherein the term of the agreement entitled "EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" executed under Spokane County Resolution No. 04-0261 and City of Spokane Document No. OPR 03-609 was extended through September 30, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the 911 Director has advised the Parties that due to delay(s) by a subcontractor (Northstar Broadcast Contractors) in conjunction with work items being completed at the Deer Park and Williams Lake sites, it is necessary to execute a change order with ADCOMM to increase its total compensation in an amount of \$3,015 from \$75,000.00 to \$78,015.40. This increase would require a corresponding amendment to the agreement entitled "EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" executed under Spokane County Resolution No. 04-0261 and City of Spokane Document No. OPR 03-609, so that the parties respective share of the total compensation would be increased as follows: 50% to be paid by the Spokane Fire Department (from \$37,500.00 to \$39,007.70); 25% to be paid by the Spokane Police Department (from \$18,750.00 to \$19,503.85); and 25% to be paid by the Sheriff's Department (from \$18,750.00 to \$19,503.85).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY AGREED among the Parties hereto that the agreement entered into under Spokane County Resolution No. 04-0261 and City of Spokane Document No. OPR 030609 entitled "EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" be and is hereby amended in Section No. 2, to provide as follows:

(Underlined language added, lined out language deleted.)

Section 2: Payment of fees. The total contract amount is not to exceed ~~\$75,000~~ \$78,015.40 for consulting tasks associated with changing the existing alphanumeric paging system to simulcast operation and working with Spokane County and City personnel to review and define the work required at radio sites most in need to immediate repair. Payment of the contract amount will be 50% by the fire service and 50% by law enforcement. The fire service amount of ~~\$37,500.00~~ \$39,007.70 will be paid by the CCC (combined communications center) funding through the Spokane Fire Department. The law enforcement share will be paid 25% by the Spokane Police Department and 25% by the Spokane County Sheriff Office, each in an amount of ~~\$18,750~~ \$19,503.85. The City total amount of payment by the Fire and Police departments shall equal ~~\$56,250.00~~ \$58,510.55.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED among the Parties hereto, that but for that change to Section No. 2. as set forth herein and that change to Section No. 6 as set forth in that agreement entitled "AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" executed under Spokane County Resolution No. 05-0920 and dated December 5, 2005 by the City and January 3, 2006 by the 911 Board, all other terms within the Agreement entitled "EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM SERVICES CONTRACT INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT" executed under Spokane County Resolution No. 04-0261 and City of Spokane Document No. OPR 03-609, shall remain in full force and effect without any change or modification whatsoever.

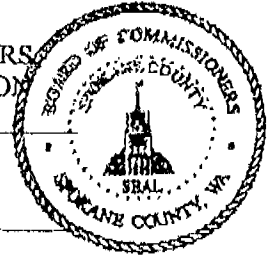
