Contract Amendment/Extension to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Spokane and Fire District #10 for fire protection and emergency services provided by the District to City property. This Amendment/Extension is for an additional two-year term (January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008) at a cost of \$15,000 per year, with \$14,750 paid by the Spokane Regional Solid Waste System and \$250 paid by the Parks Department.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Spokane and FD #10 entered into an Interlocal Agreement in March 1996 pursuant to RCW 39.34 (Interlocal Cooperation Act) and RCW 52.30.020 (State statute authorizing fire protection services). This Agreement provides for fire protection/emergency services by FD #10 at the Waste to Energy Facility, which is located within FD #10's boundary; and at City Parks Dept. property (Palisades Park and Indian Canyon Park), which is located within the City limits and is adjacent to FD #10's boundary. The lower amount paid by the Parks Dept. reflects the fact that the Parks Dept.'s properties are located adjacent to, rather than inside, FD #10's boundary.

Subject

Amendment/Extension to Interlocal Agreement between the City of Spokane and Fire District #10 (FD #10) for fire protection and emergency services provided by FD #10 to City property. This Extension will be for an additional two-year term, which will run from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008.

Background

The City of Spokane and FD #10 entered into an Interlocal Agreement in March of 1996 pursuant to RCW 39.34 (the Interlocal Cooperation Act) and RCW 52.30.020 (the State statute authorizing fire protection services). This Agreement provides for fire protection/emergency services by FD #10 at the Waste to Energy Facility, which is located within FD #10's boundary; and at City Parks Department property (Palisades Park and Indian Canyon Park), which is located within the City limits and is adjacent to FD #10's boundary.

Impact

FD #10 has requested an increase from \$12,000 to \$15,000/year for providing these services, based on additional costs the District has incurred for fuel and equipment. Compensation paid to FD #10 has not increased since 1997. Under the Interlocal Agreement, the Spokane Regional Solid Waste System will pay \$14,750/per year and the Parks Department will pay \$250/year. The lower amount paid by the Parks Department is due to the fact that the Parks Department properties are located adjacent to, rather than inside, FD #10's boundary.

Action

Staff requests the Public Works Committee's approval of this Amendment/Extension.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT / EXTENSION

THIS CONTRACT AMENDMENT is between the CITY OF SPOKANE, a Washington State municipal corporation, as "City," and SPOKANE FIRE DISTRICT NO. 10, whose address is 929 S. Garfield Road, P.O. Box 2199, Spokane, Washington 99001, as "Fire District No. 10".

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an interlocal agreement wherein Fire District No. 10 agreed to provide FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE TO CERTAIN CITY PROPERTIES; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to continue the services for an additional period of time, --

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. DOCUMENTS. The original contract dated March 8, 1996, including any previous amendment / extensions, is incorporated by reference into this document as though written in full and shall remain in full force and effect except as provided herein.
2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This contract amendment shall become effective January 1, 2007.
3. EXTENSION. The agreement is extended to run from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008.
4. COMPENSATION. The City shall pay Fire District No. 10 FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) per year for everything furnished and done under this amendment / extension.
